Indoor and outdoor housing facilities for rabbits shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair, to protect the animals from injury.

There is a mild to moderate amount of paint peeling from the areas directly surrounding the air vents in animal rooms G-11,13 & 17. Indoor animal facilities should be maintained in good repair.

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

(a) Structure: construction. Housing facilities for nonhuman primates must be designed and constructed so that they are structurally sound for the species of nonhuman primates housed in them. They must be kept in good repair, and they must protect the animals from injury.

Room #8: There is a small gap in the tile wall where the tile and grout appear to be missing. Dirt and other debris may collect in the area and may be difficult to clean as required by the Act. Housing facilities for non human primates must be kept in good repair.
