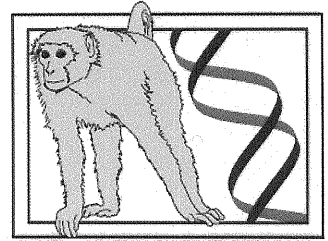

He was euthanized on November 16, 1998 at the age of 21 years due to gastrointestinal problems that were not responding to medication. His age at that time would put him in the category of late middle-age or senior.
